BANS AND DIRECTIONS TO PSA MEMBERS LIFTED

Following the PSA reissuing work bans and directions to members working in schools, the Department sought an urgent listing in the Industrial Relations Commission and the matter was heard at 3.00pm Monday, 3 December by His Honour Justice Boland, President of the Industrial Relations Commission.

The PSA implemented the bans in response to the Department's announced job cuts, and failure to adequately consult with the PSA about the introduction of change in schools.

The President strongly recommended that the bans be lifted.

His Honour also put in place a process to resolve the issues between the PSA and the Department.

The process is:

- The PSA will write to the department listing all our outstanding industrial concerns by Thursday 6 December at 4.00pm.
- The Department will respond to the PSA by the following Wednesday.

The matter is listed for compulsory conference before His Honour on 14 December, 2012 at 10.00am.

As a result of the above recommendation, the PSA is lifting the directions and bans issued on 28 and 29 November, 2012.

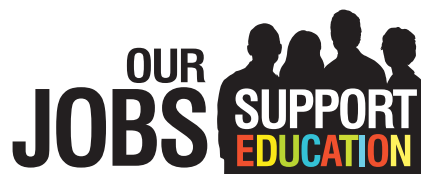
